They call them the Halal Girls.

They are three young sisters from Morocco (المغرب). They have become TV stars in the Netherlands (هولندا). They are brave sisters who want to show the true face of Islam. "We are Dutch (هولندي) of Moroccan roots but we are above all proud Muslims," says Esmaa Alariachi, 28, the elder sister. Their story began when a director of a talk show in Channel 5 wanted the sisters to have their own talk show because the girls were smart, happy and brave.

But the sisters' journey was not all rosy. Some people in the Netherlands were not happy. They did not like the idea of three Muslim girls making a successful show. "It was not easy at all for a Muslim girl with hijab to appear on TV," says, Esmaa, who was before the show an English language teacher. Some Muslims did not like the idea as well. They thought that the three girls did the wrong thing.

But the girls do not care about such people. All they want is to change people's views of Islam and Muslims. They are not afraid of speaking about anything. They talk about drugs and crime but they do not do anything that does not fit their beliefs. "Our faith supports free speech and tells us to have dialogue with others," adds Esmaa.

The sisters believe their biggest success would be to end all the wrong ideas about the Muslims in the Netherlands. Many of these ideas appeared after a young Muslim man killed the Dutch filmmaker Van Gogh. If the three girls succeed they will give much help to the one million Muslims who live in the Netherlands.
